The graphic above is from the 1980's when the US DOL embarked on a national campaign to eliminate silica exposure in US workplaces. Some thirty years later we finally have a comprehensive OSHA regulation to reduce workplace silica dust exposure. This regulation is more than just an exposure limit (PEL) as it contains detailed steps to control and prevent workers' silica exposure and related disease. The OHCC is a regional resource for trainings on this new regulation as well as medical evaluations; industrial hygiene assessments; and respirator services.
